

# Fired Up Clay Works

## Terra Cotta, the Cook's choice for 10,000 years!

Since 1980, all of our work has been created by hand, in our studio. We create each piece one at a time. We throw, build and mold our work out of a durable terra cotta clay.

After drying we paint up to 14 coats of our custom underglazes. Through this process we create colors of great depth and richness. Areas are left unpainted to show the warm, natural beauty of the clay. Our pots are then coated with our durable and lead free glaze. The colors are fired in and can never fade or wash off. Our pots are fired to 2000 degrees to make the work strong and durable.

We use traditional ceramic motifs with contemporary colors and brush work to bring fresh look to our work. Each piece is a unique work of art that brings beauty to everyday items.

Our work is ideal for the oven and dishwasher safe. Maybe reheated in the microwave.

## Poppy Field (NEW 2014)

## Old Rose, Romany and Chelsea Garden

This year we have added the new Poppy Field pattern to our art pottery designs! They all have their inspiration in the arts and crafts movement of the 1800s.

Our new Poppy Field has a field of red and yellow flowers painted on the palest of blue backgrounds. The edge is deepest cobalt. This pattern has a very Scandinavian feel.

Old Rose has a warm golden background with roses and bees.

Romany has a deep black background with bright yellow and golden orange flowers. It has an old world feel.

Chelsea Garden has a warm, deep red background with bright flowers and a bird.

We use the same colors through out the patterns so they compliment each other.

They are completely hand made and painted. The colors are layered one on top of another to give the depth of an oil painting. Each flower and leaf are the result of up to 7 coats of colors. These patterns are priced somewhat higher due to the amount of work but customers have made these their favorites,
